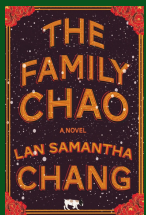

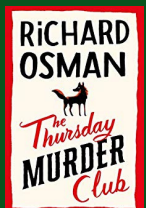

Stop in at the Berlin Public Library for fun freebies and treats all week long!



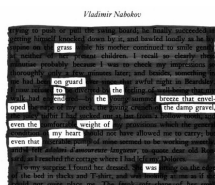
