#### Saturday, March 29 at 10 am

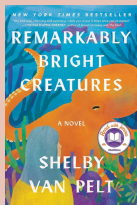

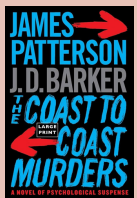
