

## DIGITIZATION SERVICE —



#### Preserve Your Memories | November 10 - 24

Do you have have old family videos, slides, or negatives you'd like to preserve in a digital format? The library will be offering a VHS to DVD (or USB drive) conversion service and a slide/film digitization service.

VHS to DVD/digital: Call ahead to reserve your spot on our list for the VHS to DVD/digital transfer service. The cost of this service is \$3 per tape. Copyrighted materials and recorded TV cannot be processed. \*Registration is required.\*

Slide/film Digitization: Come in anytime between November 10-24 (or call ahead to reserve a 2-hour time slot in advance) to use our Kodak Scanza Digital Film & Slide Scanner and convert your slides and film into digital photographs. Bring your own SD card and/or USB drive. USB drives are available for sale at the library for \$2.50.
