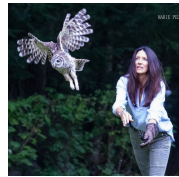
ADULT PROGRAMS

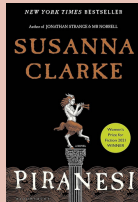
Friends Food Fundraiser at the Farmers Market | Tuesday, June 30 from 4 - 7 pm

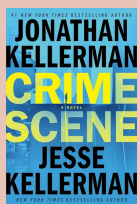
