Friday Matinee - *Killers of the Flower Moon* | Friday, May 15 at 1 pm

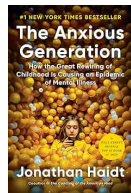
Join us for a free showing of *Killers of the Flower Moon* (rated R), starring Lily Gladstone, Leonardo DiCaprio and Robert De Niro.

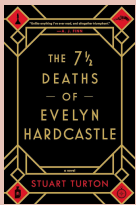
